



FULL TIME STAFF PSYCHIATRIST

Child and Family Agency of Southeastern CT, Inc. is a non-profit agency which employs approximately 180 staff, working in an array of programs which support the improved physical and mental health of children and adolescents and strengthen the functioning of families in southeastern CT. The agency's mission is to nurture children and families to develop their strengths through its service, partnership and advocacy.

Child & Family Agency of Southeastern CT, Inc. is seeking a full time staff psychiatrist. This psychiatrist will provide comprehensive mental health care within the scope of practice including mental health delivery, education, health promotion, and collaboration with patients, families, and all staff. The ability to work as a member of a team is critical.

The minimum qualification required for this position is completion of a psychiatric residency training program approved by the American Board of psychiatry and neurology. By the start of employment, candidate must possess a license to practice medicine in Connecticut.

Job Responsibilities:

- Provide comprehensive psychiatric assessment, including recommendations for medications, individual and/or family therapy. Prescribe and manage patients on psychotropic medications.
- Participate in multi-disciplinary rounds, treatment planning, and aftercare referrals and assist in crisis management with facility staff.
- Provide emergency evaluations and refer for inpatient hospitalization when indicated.
- Utilize resources to meet individual learning need and promote professional development in clinical practice.
- Participate in quality improvement programs and activities that promote patient, family, physician and staff satisfaction. Maintains awareness of current evidence-based practice and uses research applicable to patient care.
- Maintain excellent documentation of services in EMR including service plans, progress notes, medication informed consent, and other required information in compliance with agency and third party compliance standards
- Ensure documentation of services correlates with appropriate billing codes to optimize billing services
- Maintains appropriate credentials to practice
- The staff psychiatrist will travel between three of our locations within 25 miles of each other.

Position includes 3 weeks paid vacation, 5 personal days, 12 sick days and 11 paid holidays per year.
